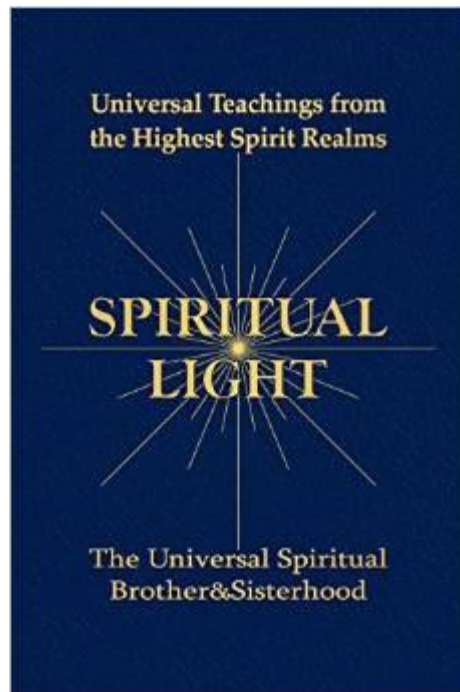

Book Review: Spiritual Light ~ by Tony Scazzero

It is not too often that you that you can read a book written from the spirit world. Spiritual Light is the philosophy of The Universal Spiritual Brother and Sisterhood (USB). Their main goal is one great spiritual brother and sisterhood under God where we are all responsible to each other. In a word, the USB mission is to spiritualize the world. Amazingly, this book encourages people to think for themselves and not just accept any spiritual viewpoint blindly. It is a refreshing pure effort to elevate humanity's consciousness through simple fundamental spiritual truths. It was written by "loving Illuminated souls from the spheres of the highest spiritual attainment offering profound wisdom" on how to live life.

The Universal Spiritual Brother and Sisterhood's principles do not appear to be man-made. In fact, they are on such a high dimension that some may deem them unrealistic or unreachable. The teachings are consistent with many spiritual founders' principles and even appear to go beyond them. 9. We should serve selflessly, as best we can, to bring love and peace and harmony to humanity, to bring the day ever nearer when all shall live in a universal spiritual brother-and-sisterhood.

The 7 Purposes of the USB are:

1. To unfold to humanity a way of life, and a new understanding of God's will and purpose.

2. To bring a universal awareness of the spark of God within each of us, and a realization that love is the greatest basis of spiritual life.
3. To bring to humanity peace and tranquility of spirit, and happiness of heart and soul.
4. To break down the barriers that stand between one nation and another, between one people and another, and between one individual and another.
5. To break down the barriers of creeds and dogmas.
6. To set aside ignorance, and replace it with truth.
7. To form one great spiritual brother-and-sisterhood throughout the world.
