
USB Happenings around the Globe

Both seek to break down barriers between people, reduce human misery, and create a more peaceful world through improved understanding of the spiritual realms.

John Finnemore's Presentation to the AREI Global Gathering. On Sunday, August 5th, a group of over 30 people gathered online to hear John's presentation to the AREI's weekly Global Gathering hosted by Wendy Zammit. Is the USB a Cult?

The short answer to this question is a categorical "No," but further elaboration accompanied by some supporting information clarifies how we arrive at this conclusion.

There are a variety of dictionary definitions for what constitutes a cult, but a predominant definition in our current times refers to a group displaying some combination of the following characteristics:

- *Exclusivity:* They may claim to be the only ones with access to the truth and restrict their followers from the free and open search for truth outside their group;
- *Secrecy:* They may require their members to take vows of confidentiality, make certain teachings selectively available among a subset of their followers, or prohibit the sharing of their teachings with outsiders;
- *Authoritarianism:* In a cult, a human leader may expect unquestioning obedience and loyalty, to the point of faddish devotion, sometimes bordering on worship;
- A system of religious beliefs, and rituals.


Reviewing various USB teachings as outlined in *SL* topics 107, *Worship Only God*, 108, *Personal Freedom for All*, and 110, *How the USB is Different*, we can assert that the USB is definitely not a cult, because:

- It is *not* exclusive, and acknowledges that all human beings are God's children;
- It is *not* secretive, welcoming all who desire to explore its universal, higher teachings and philosophy without restriction;
- Is *not* authoritarian in any way, nor is it devoted to any leader;
- It approves the worship of *only* God;
- It promotes personal freedom, encourages reasoned, rational thought, and *not* fads;
- It is *not* a religion, does *not* engage in ritualistic practices, and does *not* require anyone to give up any beliefs they may find comforting.

Finally, dear brothers and sisters, as the USB teachings routinely reiterate, "no one should accept anything unthinkingly from anyone, including from the USB". (*SL*, Topic 110:6)

Movies with Spiritual and Afterlife Themes

The 1990 movie Ghost, billed as a romantic fantasy thriller, was written by Bruce Joel Rubin and directed by Jerry Zucker. Molly, played by Demi Moore, is devastated when her boyfriend Sam, played by Patrick Swayze, is killed during a violent attack. Initially, Sam is unable to communicate with Molly from the spirit world, but as the story unfolds, and with the help of a psychic who discovers she possesses a true gift for after-death communication, the couple is able to reconnect across the "veil" before Sam returns to his eternal home.
